

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>44</sup>Then he said to them, "These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you—that everything written about me in the law of Moses, the prophets, and the psalms must be fulfilled." <sup>45</sup>Then he opened their minds to understand the scriptures, <sup>46</sup>and he said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Messiah is to suffer and to rise from the dead on the third day, <sup>47</sup>and that repentance and forgiveness of sins is to be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. <sup>48</sup>You are witnesses of these things. <sup>49</sup>And see, I am sending upon you what my Father promised; so stay here in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high."

<sup>50</sup>Then he led them out as far as Bethany, and, lifting up his hands, he blessed them. <sup>51</sup>While he was blessing them, he withdrew from them and was carried up into heaven. <sup>52</sup>And they worshiped him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy; <sup>53</sup>and they were continually in the temple blessing God.

#### **Update on General Conference**

April 23-May 3, 2024

As we continue to celebrate the work of the Holy Spirit during our denomination's time of holy conferencing in Charlotte, NC, there is much to be shared – including the news that all restrictions to full LGBTQ participation in The United Methodist Church have been removed from the *Book of Discipline*.

We look forward to deepening our discipleship practices of welcome and inclusion together with you as the UMC enters this new season of Christian unity and revival.

#### Additional actions from General Conference include:

- Approval of regionalization legislation that would restructure The United Methodist Church into different geographical regions worldwide. Each region would have equal authority to pass legislation that responds to the unique needs of its ministry context. Because this legislation requires an amendment to the church's constitution, it will need to be voted on by all annual conferences around the globe.
- A reduction in the base rate for apportionments. These "mission shares" are what local congregations and annual conferences pay towards our common ministry together as a world-wide, connectional church.
- Adoption of a newly revised set of Social Principles and a new Book of Resolutions. These statements inform the church's witness to the world. They provide the official United Methodist response to current economic, social, political, and environmental issues.
- Removal of the disaffiliation policy that was added to the Book of Discipline by the special 2019 General Conference. Addition of a reaffiliation measure to support churches that wish to rejoin the UMC.

- Approval of sacramental responsibilities for deacons, authorizing them to preside at Holy Communion and baptism in their ministry settings.
- And much more!

Exact time and location TBD based on those who sign up. I am hopeful our location can be at individuals' houses.


